

Step 1


When running Outlook Express for the first time the Connection Wizard will start automatically. Enter your name in the empty field then click *Next*

Step 2

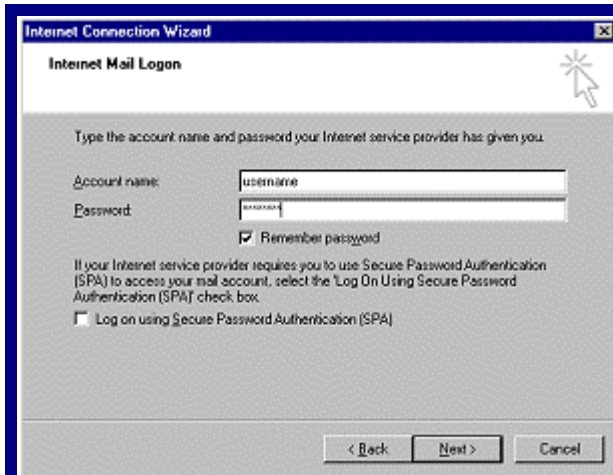
Select *I already have an e-mail account that I would like to use*. Then enter your User Name (Supplied by Velotel.com) followed by @velotel.com in the e-mail address field. Then click *Next*
